The Lilydale to Warburton Rail Trail	Yarra Junction is situated along the Lilydale-Warburton Rail Trail which allows you to walk or ride your bicycle or horse for 38 km along a clearly marked course following the route of the old railway line which was built in 1901 to relay local fruit, vegetables and timber to the Melbourne line.
Healesville Sanctuary	Not far away is the famous Healesville Sanctuary, with its comprehensive displays of Australian fauna. Education service can be arranged. Barbecue facilities are available.
Toolangi Forest Discovery Centre	The Toolangi Forest Education Program aims to enable students to better understand the distribution, ecology, use and management of forests in Victoria.
Mt Donna Buang Rainforest Gallery and Skywalk	At Cement Creek, around 10 km from the summit of Mount Donna Buang, is the Rainforest Gallery which consists of a series of steps down to the lush forest floor. The Mount Donna Buang Skywalk is a 17m high elevated walkway through the tree tops.
Mt Donna Buang Snowplay	Tobogganing and snow play in winter on beautiful Mount Donna Buang.
Haining Farm	See the working of an operating dairy farm. This 65-ha dairy farm, with its Jersey and Friesian cows and other farm animals, is located amidst green hills at the confluence of the Yarra and Don Rivers. Tour the farm and enjoy a talk by the farm manager.
Canoeing and Rafting	Canoeing on Lilydale Lake or gentle rafting on the Yarra River. Professional instructors and equipment available to introduce your group to water skills and techniques.
Caving and Hiking	Britannia Creek Cave is a suitable cave for beginners as it is fairly short, has many entrances and contains a flowing stream. To experience the delights of hiking and bush walking what better place to go than the scenic forests of the Upper Yarra Valley.
