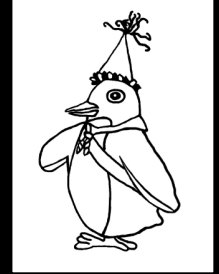

Kit List

Make sure you bring everything on the kit list and it is NAMED!!

You will have to carry your luggage from the gate to your campsite so you will have to make sure you can handle it yourself.

You will have a personalised kit list and you may need to bring extra items for your chosen activities. Make sure you name and pack these too!

Check out your kit list and at the top you will find which sub camp you are in.

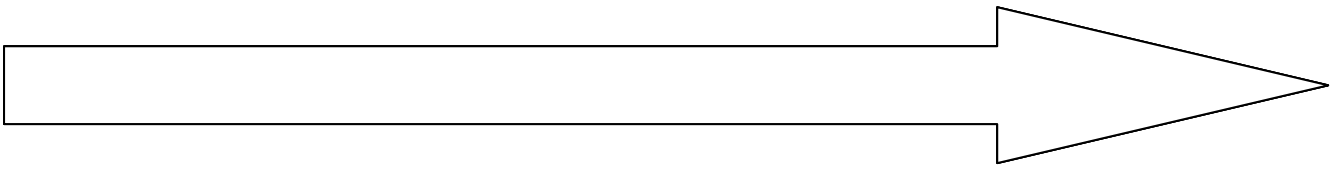
It will have a decade such as 1960 and a colour. Which one are you in? If you are coming with other members of your unit or district you will find that at least one of the people you know are in the same sub camp.



Registration

When you arrive at ACE, you will need to follow the arrows to registration in the indoor horse arena- The Ace Space.

1. Leave your luggage under the trees (there will be a sign).
The only thing you need with you to register is your health form, so don't forget to bring that to camp and to registration.
2. Follow the arrows to the Ace Space and line up in your sub camp line. Look for the name and colour of your sub camp. There will be people to help you.
3. At registration you will hand in your health form and collect in an ACE bag your camp pouch, the acebook, hat, drink bottle, insulated lunch box, badge and polo shirt.
4. Then return to your luggage and follow the coloured signs to your sub camp.
There will be runners waiting to help you find your sub camp.



Each sub camp is divided into camp units and each camp unit is divided into patrols. Check your camp pouch and it will indicate which camp unit and patrol you are in. People in your sub camp will help you. You will find others there putting up their tents. When you arrive it will be time to pitch in and help put up the tents in your unit.

Pocket Money

You may wish to bring some pocket money to buy souvenirs from the ACE Shop, the canteen, stamps from the Post Office, penguinalia from the Penguin Parade, the odd ice cream or cold drink!!

On Site Activities

You will have an opportunity to choose your on site activities when you arrive at camp.

If on arrival you find you are on site on Monday 4 January you will need to choose your activity/activities before 7.30pm on the Sunday.

If you are on site on the Thursday you will have the opportunity to choose your activities on Tuesday morning. Lists of available activities will be in the Ace Space.
