Canoeing and Rafting

Haining Farm - Ph 5967 3202

See the working of an operating dairy farm. Tour the farm and enjoy a talk by the farm manager, only available through the week.

Healesville Sanctuary - Ph 5962 4022

Not far away is the famous Healesville Sanctuary, with its comprehensive displays of Australian fauna. Education service can be arranged. Barbecue facilities are available.

Hiking and Bushwalking

Trout Fishing - Ph 5966 2054
