Policy	The Policy provides direction to those handling and selling food on behalf of Girl Guides Victoria.		
Principles	The policy covers all fundraising activities selling food including but not exclusive to: • Sausage sizzles • Cake stalls • Barbeques • Fetes and markets • Paid catering events		
Definitions	'Handling and selling' refers to food that is being handled for the purpose of selling it.		
Procedures under this policy	 The organiser of the event is required to: Contact the relevant local municipal council for a permit. Meet the requirements of the municipal council's specific policies. To prepare and serve all food safely regardless of the stipulations or lack of by the municipal council. All food for sale must be labelled and ingredients displayed particularly relating to those possibly containing allergens. Hold a current 'Streatrader' certificate.
