There are many different types of volunteering position available:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Our Chalet Assistant - this is a seasonal position of 3 months (2 in autumn). • Short Term Volunteer - this position is as required for special projects and usually lasts 2 weeks to 1 month. • Ready Steady Go 24 April – 1 May 2018- this is an annual event for volunteers to help prepare Our Chalet for the summer season. • Intern positions - these are 3 to 6 month positions in a variety of roles depending on the season. <p>Join our volunteer team and be a part of the Our Chalet success story! Please note: Swiss visa rules mean you must be aged under 35 at the time of volunteering and have not previously had a volunteer visa for Switzerland.</p> <p><u>Financial Assistance</u> If you are selected as a volunteer, Our Chalet will provide you with all meals, accommodation, use of self-service laundry facilities and wireless internet access in designated areas on site for the duration of your stay. Our Chalet has a scholarship fund that you can apply to for travel assistance. Depending on where you are travelling from, we are usually able to offer travel scholarships of CHF 500 – 1000.
