With your Unit, look at some flags from countries and places around the world.

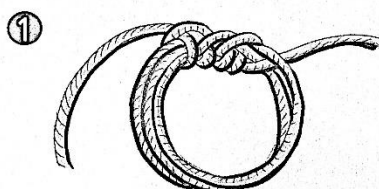
What similarities can you see? What colours are the most popular? What designs are popular? What designs are unique?

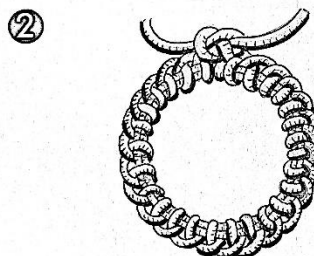
### Making a grommet

A grommet is a strong eyelet/loop, normally made from rope or string. It is used at the top of a hand-constructed flagpole for the rope attached to a flag to pass through, so that the flag can be raised and lowered. Make a grommet in one of your online meetings. Everyone will need a piece of string, rope, or wool.

#### Grommet



*Using a thin cord, start with a clove hitch, then use half hitches over loops of cord.*



*End with a reef knot.*
