



Recycled Gift – Rolled Magazine Photo Frame

Materials:

- An old photo frame
- A magazine
- Ruler
- Glue (PVA or similar)
- Brush
- Skewer
- Scissors

Instructions:

1. Tear out the pages of your magazine – pick out the most colourful pages for the best effect.
2. Measure the width of your frame with your ruler.
3. Measure and cut strips of magazine the same width as your frame.
4. Take one strip and fold it in half. Fold it in half again. Cut along the folds so that you have four small strips.
5. Take one of the small strips. Work out which side you want to use – keep that on the outside. Roll it tightly around the skewer, making a tube. When there's about half a centimetre left, smear some glue on to fasten. Finish rolling and hold in place for a couple of seconds to set. Pull the tube off the skewer.
6. Repeat until you have enough tubes to cover your frame.
7. Lay down your frame, and squeeze on two lines of glue down one side of the frame. Stick the tubes on, nice and close together.
8. Repeat on remaining sides of the frame.
9. Add a nice picture into the frame – maybe one of you!
10. Give it to someone you love!
