



Reef Knot

The reef knot (also known as a square knot) is used for tying two ropes of equal thickness together.

It is a very useful knot as it holds strong when tension is on either end, sits flat, and is still easy to undo.

It can be used for:

- Triangular bandages/slings
- Joining two lengths of rope into one

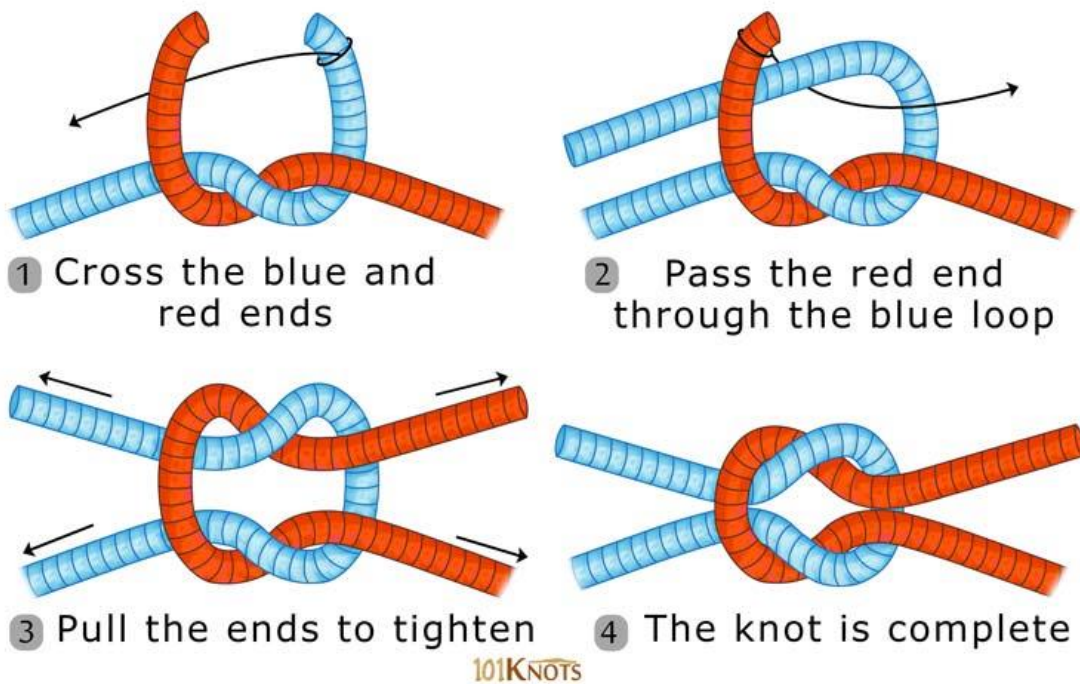
