

HOW TO SEW ON A BADGE

(onto a Girl Guide sash, camp blanket, bag, camp hat, etc.)

Materials needed:

- New badge (maybe <u>this one!</u>)
- Girl Guide sash, camp blanket, bag, camp hat, etc.
- Sewing needle
- Sewing scissors
- Thread that is the same colour as the border of your new badge
- Pins
- Pin cushion (optional)

Instructions:

- 1. Pin your new badge in place to whatever you are sewing it on. These instructions refer to a Girl Guide sash.
- 2. Thread the needle with the thread.
- 3. Tie a knot at the end of the thread. You may need to make a knot a few times to ensure it doesn't pull through the badge.
- 4. Start sewing!
- 5. Use a stitch that comes up from the back of the sash, through the badge (just inside the border is great), over the badge border, and then back through the sash.
- 6. Keep doing this until you have sewn around the badge. Remember to secure the thread at the back of the sash once you're finished by tying a knot to ensure the badge doesn't come loose.

Some clever tips!

- Don't have more thread than two arms' lengths or it will get tangled.
- To make threading your needle easier, check that the end of the thread has a neat cut. If it is frayed, snip off the end to tidy up.
- Don't sew on a badge with a straight stitch you need to sew up and over the edge of the badge to keep it secure.
- If you run out of thread, tie a good knot and keep going with a new length of thread.
