



CRAYON ART

You will need:

- Old tarp/groundsheet, newspaper, or plastic to work on
- Canvas or heavy paper
- Hot glue gun
- 24-pack of crayons
- Hair dryer

Make sure you ask for help, permission, and/or supervision before starting this project!

Instructions:

1. Use an old tarp or similar to protect your workspace.
2. Stick your crayons to the canvas or paper in any pattern you choose. It works best if they are all facing the same direction.
3. Use your hair dryer to heat the ends of the crayons - they will start to drip downwards.
4. Heat higher up the crayons and the drips will slowly start to get bigger and travel down the page.
5. Allow to dry completely.
6. Hang up your masterpiece!

Tip: If you want some of the canvas to stay white, use tape and peel it off once the canvas is dry.
