



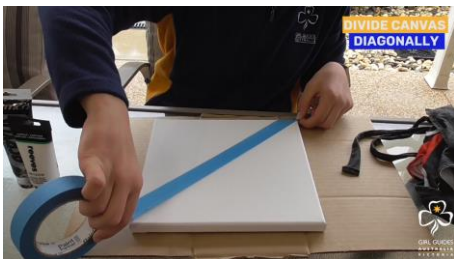
Line Art Embroidery on Canvas

You will need:

- Canvas (any size)
- Paint
- Paint brush
- Masking tape OR painter's tape
- Embroidery thread
- Needle
- Paper and pencils

Instructions:

1. Place tape halfway across your canvas in a diagonal line to separate the two sides. Paint one half of the canvas and leave to dry completely before painting the other side.



2. Using your sheet of paper, draw a design (a simple outline works best) the size you want it to be on the canvas. You could also print out a picture from Google.
3. Once your paint is dry, place your piece of paper on top of the canvas in the spot you want your design to be.



4. Use a needle to poke holes through the paper onto the canvas, following the lines of your design, leaving a gap approximately 0.5cm-1cm between the holes.



5. Remove the paper and use embroidery thread to “sew” your design onto the canvas, following the holes you made. You can use two different coloured threads to make your design stand out.
