



How to Make 'Oobleck'

You will need:

- Jug of water
- Spoons
- Food dye
- Bowl or tray
- Corn flour

Instructions:

1. Empty the corn flour into a large bowl or tray.
2. Add some water, and mix it up. Start with a little bit of water, and add more if your mixture is too dry!
3. The consistency you want is running when you're mixing slow, and solid when you're mixing fast.
4. Add your favourite colour of food dye. Just a few drops!



GGTV TIP: Try STANDING on a tray of oobleck. What happens?

What's happening?

Oobleck is a 'non-Newtonian' fluid, which means it doesn't behave like a regular liquid! It changes viscosity (how thick it is) depending on how much stress is placed on it.
