All youth member medications must be handed in at sign-in to the First Aider. Please ensure all medications are listed on the Health Form (which will be emailed to all youth participants prior to the event), and are in original packaging in a snap-lock bag clearly labelled with the Guide's full name and dosage instructions.

Please note that GGV Volunteers are not permitted to issue any medication to participants without the consent of their guardian.
