<u>Membership Invoices</u> are due out on or around the 7<sup>th</sup> February. This year's membership will show an increase to \$65. This \$5.00 increase reflects a rise in the GGA / WAGGGS fees. All payments should be made by the end of February.

Invoices for Life Members will be sent to the Life Member who should pass on the invoice to her Trefoil Guild for payment. Unfortunately the IMAS database cannot send the Life Member's invoice to the Secretary.

<u>Congratulations go to Marg Devlin</u> who has been appointed a Life Member of Girl Guides Victoria – from the citation written by Janelle Howell: "Marg has given much to Girl Guides in Victoria, Australia and across the world. <u>Child Safe Child Friendly</u> – Trefoil Guild has until the end of 2023 to comply with the Child Safe Child Friendly requirements set out by Girl Guides Australia. One of the easiest things to do is to get your Working With Children Check (WWCC). Instructions were sent out to the Secretaries late last year

A Working with Children Check is a screening process that all Trefoil Guild members need to have to be compliant as a member of Girl Guides Victoria.

It is a process done over the Internet where some forms of your identification must be verified to submit the application.

If you click here (https://www.workingwithchildren.vic.gov.au/individuals/applicants/how-to-apply-2), it will automatically take you to begin an application form.

If you already have a Working with Children Check or have had one, please add Girl Guides Victoria as an organisation that you volunteer with on your working with children check.
