

# 2022 ANZAC Day March in the City

Monday 25<sup>th</sup> April

Federation Square 7.30am to approx.1pm

Girl Guides Victoria have once again been invited to participate in the annual Anzac Day Parade from Federation Square to The Shrine in the Royal Botanical Gardens.



**Who:** Guides aged 10+ and Leaders

**Where:** Assemble at the Banner Pool Area in Federation Square

**When:** Monday 25<sup>th</sup> April between 7.30am to 8am, until approximately 1pm

Participants must bring Activity Permission form (ADM27) form to attend.

Please report to Laura or Heather on arrival at Federation Square.

During the march, Guides carry Unit signs and/or banners representing each of the Units.

When participants reach The Shrine, signs and banners are handed to a Marshall. After the Marshall has received the signs and banners a Leader will instruct the Guides to return to the Banner Pool at Federation Square. At the end of the march all Youth Members and Leaders will gather and walk down St. Kilda Rd on mass with the Scouts. Every Youth Member will get the opportunity to carry a Unit sign or banner.

Public Transport is free for Guides and Leaders in uniform participating in the march.

### **Uniform Requirements:**

- Correct uniform is vital to participate in the march. Please refer to the [Uniform Guidelines](#).
- Wear comfortable shoes that are plain black or dark brown, such as school shoes – no bright colours or stripes will be permitted on the day.
- A Girl Guides Australia uniform hat must be worn in all weather conditions.
- If wet weather is forecasted a clear plastic poncho should be worn so that uniform can still be seen.
- Please do not bring back packs or any bags as there is nowhere to leave bags or belongings. Everything should fit into pockets, or be left with your Leader or parent/s in attendance.

### **Additional Information:**

- Activity Permission Form (ADM27) to be carried by all Youth Members in their pocket.
- Remember to bring a full water bottle and a snack.
- We request that Unit Leaders make sure their Guides have a mobile phone number of a Leader or their parent/s who are in attendance on the day in case of an emergency or if they get separated from the group.
- In case of an incident or emergency the GGV Liaison (Heather Hyatt) will carry a mobile phone. St John's Ambulance will be in attendance for the duration of the march.
