For the 4th year in a row, Girl Guides Victoria will proudly be marching in the Midsumma 2023 Pride March in St Kilda!

The 2023 Pride March will be held on Sunday 5 February, and we'd love you to come join Youth and Leaders in participating in the event, a wonderfully fun, colourful, and inclusive experience!

All 10yrs+ members of Girl Guides Victoria are invited to march, including those who identify as LGBTQIA+ and who are an ally.

Adults in attendance on the day will be the Leader in Charge, Co-Leader and other Guides Victoria Adult members.

All Youth Members attending on the day must have their Health Forms signed by a parent/guardian and brought with them on the day.

Friends, family, and supporters are most welcome to march with us.

The Pride March is an LGBTQIA+ community event and celebrates diverse genders and sexualities. Those who attend and march in the parade may see or hear things they have not previously been exposed to. Girl Guides Victoria therefore requires that youth members 10–13yrs march with, and be under the supervision of, a parent/guardian over the age of 18 OR their Guide Leader.

When: Sunday 5 February 2023.

The March officially commences at 11.00 am. Guides marching will be expected to gather at 10.00 am.

Where: Along Fitzroy Street in St Kilda, from Lakeside Drive to Catani Gardens. A more detailed description of when & where Girl Guides Victoria members are to meet for the March will be communicated closer to the event.

Transport: We recommend travelling by public transport if possible as parking will be difficult nearby. Please note that there will be changes to tram routes. Details about public transport options will be available on the **Public Transport Victoria** website closer to the date. Current recommendations are listed on the Midsumma website.

Uniform: Both youth and adult members should wear their Guide uniform polo shirt. You can get creative with rainbow accessories, and accessories in other LQBTQIA+ community flag colours. See the links back on the event website. Jeans and shorts are acceptable, and please wear comfortable closed toed shoes. You MUST wear an appropriate hat.

Being sun-smart: Please be prepared for the weather and stay hydrated! Participants without a hat will not be permitted to march. We advise bringing a reusable drink bottle to the March in a small back-pack along with sunscreen. Free water refilling stations will be available at both the marshalling grounds and Catani Gardens.

Valuables: Please leave valuables at home. The event will be busy and noisy and things could be easily misplaced. Please bring a suitable backpack to carry required items. GGV will not be responsible for lost possessions.

All posts will make clear that we have LGBTQIA+ members as well as friends, supporters, and allies marching. If you are not comfortable being photographed please make yourself known to organisers of the Guide contingent on the day.
