- ✓ Have you invited new potential members to join in an activity with you Guild?
- ✓ Revisited the purpose of your Guild? Is it to support Girl Guiding, the community, or just to socialize and to SHINE while having FUN? Are all of your members on board with your purpose?
- ✓ Have you listed the "Skills" of your members then offered to help the local Girl Guide Unit to learn these skills from you. FACTS ABOUT THE BLACKBURN FUND:

The role of this fund has been superseded lately with the Victorian Government kids get healthy vouchers that pays \$200 towards Guides memberships should their family qualify. We are looking to build our reach in priority disadvantaged areas and may seek to use some of the Blackburn bursary to assist with recruiting and supporting volunteers and then Guides.

Q:Would the preference be to give to the Blackburn Fund or the Flood Relief Fund at the present time?

A: Blackburn fund as we have raised close to \$5k and we also received grants per unit from Victorian government.

The current balance of the Blackburn Bursary reserve is \$216,040.00

There has been an increase in the requests for funding due to the recent flood and or the increase in the cost of living.

Q: Is the Blackburn Fund in need of more funds urgently?

A: Not urgent but yes it can do with more funds and this is the basis of our fundraising aim for this year.

Explanation of our Membership Fees for 2023:

Firstly, please remember that our memberships fees are due on 31st May this year and future years. This is to bring us into line with other members of Girl Guide Victoria. Your invoice will be coming to you early in May. Please do not send in your membership before your invoice arrives.

There is a \$10 rise for members who don't have Police Checks, Working with Children Checks or their Child Safe Child Friendly Module. As volunteers there isn't any charge to apply for these, but the staff at Girl Guides Victoria have to spend time checking and entering this information onto our data base hence the \$10 PER YEAR admin fee.

If members have a full membership with Girl Guides Victoria an admin fee is built in already.






WEGGSS Trefoil Guild off to celebrate Thinking Day
