What Do Girl Guides Do?



Our programs empower girls to take charge of their lives, build leadership skills and connect with their communities. In our supportive environment, girls are encouraged to speak up, explore their interests, and grow confidence in their abilities. From outdoor adventures and fun STEM activities to helping others and learning about themselves, there's something at Guides for everyone.

What Do Girl Guides Wear?



Guides are required to wear a Girl Guides Polo Shirt and navy bottoms, along with a sash to display their badges. Optional items, such as hoodies, fleeces, and hats, are available. Members can also wear culturally sensitive and practical items, such as long-sleeved tops, long pants, and head scarves, along with their polo shirts.

Who Supervises the Girl Guides?



Girl Guide Units and activities are run by a team of volunteers called 'Guide Leaders'. Guide Leaders are trustworthy and skilled leaders who give their time to mentor, challenge and support each Girl Guide.

Who Can Join Girl Guides?



Girls aged 5-17 can join Girl Guides and take part in the Guide Program. Each local Unit may have different age groups, so check with your local Unit to see which ages they accept.

When Do Girl Guides Meet?



Girl Guide Units meet once per week on weekdays, after school and in the evenings during school terms. Guides can also choose to take part in camps, excursions, and adventure activities, as well as a school holiday program that offers fun and adventure in various locations throughout the year.

How Do I Join Girl Guides?

Your child can try Guides for up to three meetings before deciding to join. To start a trial, use the website to find your nearest Guide Unit and request a Trial.
