WHO AND WHAT

Colour Camp will bring together three regions for a fun and exciting weekend of adventure at Britannia Park Campsite.

You will be assigned patrols and have the opportunity to engage in exciting activities within these groups as well as with other Guides from across the regions.

PROGRAM

The theme for this year's camp will be Colour. There will be two days of activities including activities within your camp on Friday night and a joint campfire Saturday night.

ACTIVITIES

On day one, you will be able to choose your own direction and pick two of the following activities. Please make sure to select your choices on registration.

Choice one:

- Water fun at Lilydale – Canoeing (this will be a whole day activity, so you won't have a second selection)
- Outdoor rope survivor challenge
- Fun with outdoor cooking
- Deep dive into the world of STEM
- Guiding through craft creatively

Choice two:

- Cave exploring (13+)
- Possum flyer (minimum height 100cm)
- Climbing (minimum height 100cm)
- Robotics
- Flying fox (minimum height 100cm, maximum weight 120kg)
- Crate stacking (10+, minimum height 100cm)
- Orienteering
- Chill zone



TRANSPORT AND ACCOMMODATION

TRANSPORT

Buses will pick up Guides and Volunteers from local pick-up points on Friday afternoon, and will drop back to the same location on Sunday late afternoon. Region buses will be supervised by Girl Guide Leaders, please pick your location on registration. Please note that you may have to drive to your bus departure hub.

Adult members who wish to drive can email Dani Smith at dani.smith@guidesvic.org.au to request a car park. Please note that not all requests can be accommodated, as car parking is limited and we have leader ratio requirements on the buses.

ACCOMMODATION

Indoor beds will be available for Guides aged 5-7, with limited places available (24 places). You will need to select this on registration. Guides can also choose to sleep in tents with their unit.

There will be a 13+ sub camp for those that are part of a mixed age unit but would like to camp with older Guides.

All other Guides and their leaders will be sleeping outdoors in tents. Guides will be placed in sub-camps with their local Units and friends.



MEDICATION AND MOBILE PHONES

MEDICATION

All personal medication (except asthma puffers and Epipens) must be:

- Handed in to your sub-camp First Aider (this includes pain killers like paracetamol and ibuprofen)
- In its original packaging in a snap-lock bag clearly labelled with: Guide's full name and dosage instructions
- Listed on the Health Form

Girl Guides Victoria Volunteers are not permitted to issue any medication to Girl Guides without the consent of their parent/guardian.

If you have any questions or concerns about health & first aid at camp, including if you are worried about sleeping in a tent, please contact Dani Smith at dani.smith@guidesvic.org.au as soon as possible to discuss.

MOBILE PHONE, TECHNOLOGY, AND VALUABLES

KIT LIST

- Please ensure all items are labelled

CLOTHING

- ☐ Guide Uniform
- ☐ Closed toed shoes x2 (no sandals)
- ☐ Tops/T-shirts x4 (with sleeves to stay sun smart)
- ☐ Pants/skirts/shorts (at least knee length)
- ☐ Warm jumper
- ☐ Beanie/gloves/scarf (optional)
- ☐ Socks & underpants x5
- ☐ Old clothes & trainers (to get wet/muddy - long pants and long sleeves are essential for the caving activity)
- ☐ Pyjamas
- ☐ Plastic bags (for wet/dirty clothes)

SLEEPING GEAR

In a bedroll, or packed neatly in a bag

- ☐ Sleeping mat (foam or self-inflatable - NO 'lilos' or stretchers - not required for indoors)
- ☐ Sleeping bag (quality, temperature rated sleeping bag)
- ☐ Pillow
- ☐ Camp blanket
- ☐ Inner sheet (optional)
- ☐ Fitted sheet (only for those sleeping indoors)
- ☐ Tarp & rope (even if not making a bedroll)



KIT LIST

TOILETRIES

In a snap lock bag or toiletries bag

- ☐ Toothbrush and toothpaste
- ☐ Towel
- ☐ Deodorant
- ☐ Hairbrush and hair ties/bobby pins, etc.
- ☐ Sanitary products (if applicable)

OTHER

- ☐ Drink bottle (minimum 600 ml)
- ☐ Sunglasses
- ☐ Health form, medications, medical management plans
- ☐ Snack to eat on the bus
- ☐ Torch & spare batteries
- ☐ Waterproof jacket (with a hood and long enough to sit on)
- ☐ Personal first aid kit (including; sunscreen, insect repellent, lip balm & band-aids)
- ☐ Sun-hat (wide-brimmed preferred)
- ☐ Sit upon (small square of thin plastic e.g. a bag/tarp big enough to sit on)
- ☐ Dilly bag with tea towel
- ☐ Non-breakable plate, bowl, cup, knife, fork, spoon (x2 of each)

- ☐ Camera
