Patrol Name:

General Layout

- Clear path fire to woodpile
- Clear path fire to kitchen
- Clear path fire to fire buckets
- Clear path kitchen to water source
- All gear at least 3m from fire
- Trip hazards are marked
- Sleeping tent door located sensibly
- Noticeboard in a prominent location
- Flagpole in a prominent location

Fire setup

- Fire laid for cooking
- Fire laid with appropriately sized wood
- All wood is safely inside fireplace
- Fire is covered
- Ground around the fire cleared of fuel
- At least two fire buckets near the fire
- Fire buckets full of water
- Fire buckets have hessian inside

Woodpile

- 3m from fire
- In a well thought out location
- Raised
- Covered with tarp (if appropriate)

- Water will drain off roof
- Guy ropes taut
- Guy ropes at correct angle
- Pegs in securely
- Location is well considered (flat, no tripping hazards, location to water, fit pit ect.)
- Round turn and 2 half hitches or runner used appropriately

Sleeping tent/s

- Location well considered
- Stable
- Pitched correctly
- Guy ropes taut
- Guy ropes at correct angle
- Round turn and 2 half hitches or runner used appropriately
- Pegs in securely
- Fly is not touching tent
- No evidence of food in tents
- No gear touching tent walls
- Inside tent is neat and tidy

- No food floating in water
