TRANSPORT AND ACCOMODATION

TRANSPORT

Please be aware that, despite the name, the location of the camp is in Wensleydale and not Anglesea

From Melbourne

- Travel south-west towards Geelong via Princes Highway (M1)
- When at Geelong turn-off follow Geelong Ring Road
- When arriving at Waurn Ponds veer right and stay on the Princes Highway (M1) towards Colac and continue for 3 km.
- At Cape Otway Rd (C135) turn left and follow for 20 km.
- Turn left at Wensleydale Station Road and follow for 6 km.
- Entrance to Anglesea Valley Lodge will be on your left

From Anglesea

- Exit Anglesea West via Noble St
- Continue straight onto Harvey St
- Slight right to stay on Aireys Inlet
- Anglesea Rd, follow for 1.5 km
- Turn right onto Bald Hills Rd, follow for 9 km.
- Turn left onto Gum Flats Rd and follow for 4.5 km
- Turn right onto Wensleydale Station Road- Entrance to Anglesea Valley Lodge will be on your right



KIT LIST

- Please ensure all items are labelled
- Please check the list but allow your Guide to pack their own bag
- Make sure she can manage their belongings and carry their bag
- Please bring **NO FOOD, DRINK OR LOLLIES**
- Do NOT bring anything valuable. Mobile phones not encouraged and all valuables are brought at owners own risk.
- For adult volunteers: Anglesea Valley Lodge is a smoke/alcohol free venue.

WEAR TO CAMP

- ☐ Guide Uniform (Guide shirt & jeans/blue pants)
- ☐ Warm outer layer
- ☐ Closed toed shoes

CLOTHING

- ☐ Extra pair of closed toed shoes (no sandals)
- ☐ Socks & underpants
- ☐ Tops/T-shirts (with sleeves to stay sun smart)
- ☐ Pants/skirts/shorts (at least knee length)
- ☐ Pyjamas/bed socks
- ☐ Raincoat (fully waterproof and long enough to sit on)
- ☐ Beanie/sunhat (wide brimmed)
- ☐ Gumboots (if it's rained recently)

SLEEPING GEAR

- ☐ Sleeping bag (quality, temperature rated sleeping bag)
- ☐ Pillow slip (actual pillow not required)
- ☐ Camp blanket (wool recommended)
- ☐ Fitted sheet



KIT LIST

TOILETRIES

In a snap lock bag or toiletries bag

- ☐ Toothbrush and toothpaste
- ☐ Towel
- ☐ Face flannel
- ☐ Deodorant (non aerosol)
- ☐ Hairbrush and hair ties/bobby pins, etc.
- Sanitary products (if applicable)

OTHER

- ☐ Drink bottle (minimum 600 ml)
- ☐ Health form, medications, medical management plans
- ☐ Torch & spare batteries
- ☐ Sit upon (a small square or thing plastic e.g. a bag or tarp big enough to sit on)
- ☐ Plastic bags (for wet/dirty clothes)
